

LONDON MINOR LACROSSE ASSOCIATION

TEAM SPONSORSHIP GUIDELINES

All funds (and items) donated to London Minor Lacrosse Association (LMLA) are to be allocated to General Revenues for the benefit of the entire organization as determined by the Board of Directors (Board).

Sponsorships may be acknowledged by sponsor bars (printed or sewn) on team sweaters, listing on the Sponsors page on the LMLA website, sponsor appreciation plaques and any other means of acknowledgement as the Board may deem appropriate. The items initialed and agreed to on the sponsorship agreement will determine the acknowledgement commitment.

Sponsorships may be acknowledged on specific teams if such acknowledgement is practical from a timing and costing point of view. No guarantees will be made that specific sponsors will be linked to specific teams unless such linkage is specifically agreed to by the LMLA Board or its authorized representative on the sponsorship form. LMLA will provide donation receipts if requested for money received by the organization.

Only remedies specifically noted and agreed to by LMLA on the sponsorship form will be considered if LMLA commitments are not met.

LMLA will not accept donations targeted to specific teams unless the money is to be used to accelerate normally scheduled team or LMLA asset purchases, and where these assets will remain the property of the Association and meets any and all criteria as may be set out by the Board.

Individual teams are allowed to fund raise to cover their operating costs but must handle cheque cashing and receipts internally (coach or manager). No LMLA receipts will be provided for team based donations. It is strongly recommended that individual team sponsors be informed in writing that their donations are team specific. It is recommended that each team provide a detailed income statement showing sources and uses of all funds to be made available to all parents and interested sponsors at the end of each season

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
